

## Guidance for Applying Your Numbers

Please read this before applying your numbers

To be eligible to score points in the NORC Championship, you must enter all events under your NORC allocated number. All NORC competitors will have a 3 digit competition number beginning with the number 2. The reason for this is to help with results at Interclub events but **will** apply to NORC championship events.

Numbers are to be applied as per blue book sections J.4.1, J.4.1.1 and P.50.5.1.

An extract from J.4.1 & J.4.1.1 states - numbers must be displayed in a durable manner and be black, and a minimum size of 23cm (230mm) high and with a stroke width of 3.8cm (38mm) on a white oblong background measuring not less than 48cm x 33cm (480mm x 330mm) which must extend at least 5cm (50mm) outside the numbers. If on a white vehicle the background must be delineated at 48cm x 33cm by a continuous black line.

P.50.5.1 states - competition numbers must be displayed on both sides of the vehicle, behind the front doors and above the vehicle waistline, and must be displayed parallel to the vehicle sides.

The smaller front stickers required for NORC championship events as stated in the NORC SR's are to be applied to the front of the vehicle to aid the timekeepers where vehicle visibility is limited. They have to be placed on the white background supplied, on the passenger side at the top corner of the windscreen or the bodywork just above. Seeding lane stickers are to be placed in front of the numbers also on the white background, or on the passenger front wing if this is not possible.

Where seeding lanes are in operation you must join the correct queue unless instructed to do otherwise by a marshal. If you join the wrong queue you will be made to join the back of the correct queue.
