### Committee Proposals

- Team championship
  - Only entry for £10 for a team
  - 3 Drivers / cars per team (3min, 3 max)
  - Driver can only be in 1 team
  - All 3 drivers points from each event to make up team points
  - All rounds to count
  - Winning team received trophy and prize at the end of the year (at dinner dance)
- Splitting each day of the weekend to being a single event
  - Each weekend will have 2 round of the championship.
  - Each day will be treated as a separate event.
  - Out of 10 round championship (5 weekends) up to 3 dropped round, (3 days)
  - Pay for entry to Saturday or Sunday, or discount price for weekend package that includes both races.
  - Trophies awarded at end of each day for winners.
    - 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> overall and class winners.

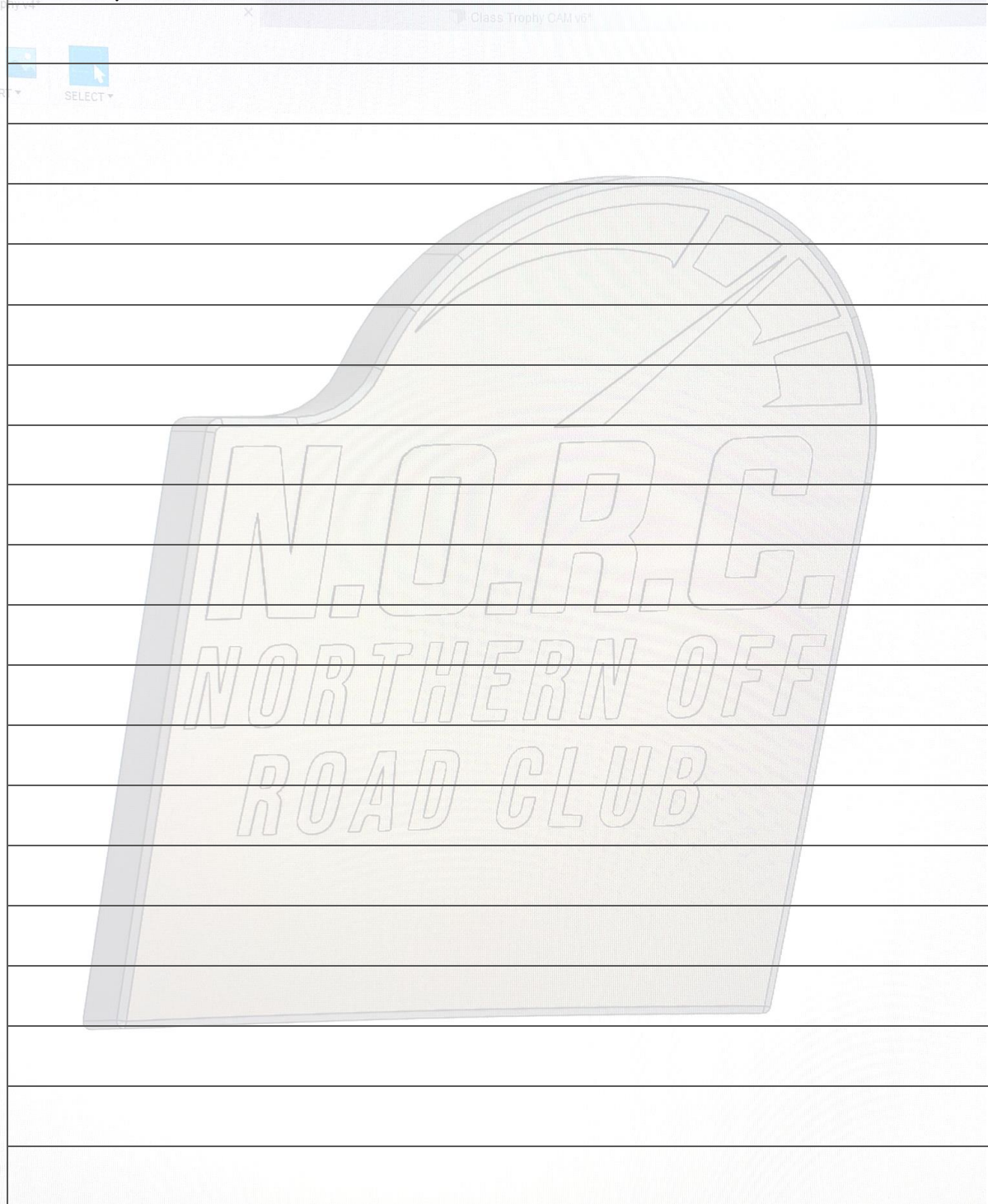
